Job Summary:

Saint John's is seeking a full-time Director of the Parish Life Center (PLC) to create and develop opportunities for ministry within the parish and surrounding community. The mission of the PLC is to provide a safe and welcoming space for parishioners of Saint John's and the Memphis community to care for the spiritual and physical well-being of ourselves and our neighbor. The PLC achieves this mission by promoting and providing a clean and well-maintained facility for fitness, recreation, wellness, community events, outreach, fellowship, and Christian formation.

The Director will build and strengthen the relationship between the parish and the PLC; provide strategic direction to help the facility grow and profit; work closely with Family Formation, Outreach and PLC Committees to establish and schedule enrichment programs and events; evaluate their effectiveness and identify future relationships. The Director oversees and manages the facility usage, front desk staff, staff, budget, and event calendar.

- Develop and implement fitness and recreation programs, including but not limited to sports leagues youth and adults, workout facilities, group fitness classes, wellness workshops
- Establish and maintain parish and neighborhood engagement with community enrichment, after school enrichment and adult enrichment activities and programs
- Work with Outreach Committee to identify neighborhood outreach opportunities to be held in the PLC
- Establish partnerships with other organizations for the purpose of hosting community wide events
- Coordinate and schedule children, youth and parish wide events and programs with Director of Family Formation
- Oversee, coordinate and schedule the logistics of all activities held in the PLC and Athletic Field
- Promote and market PLC to the parish and community
- Generate revenue through building rental for events, meetings, programs, fitness classes, personal trainers and membership fees
- Recruit, hire, train and manage PLC staff
- Manage daily operations of PLC
- Responsible for security and alarms for PLC
- Coordinate the cleaning, buying of supplies and general maintenance of PLC and Athletic Field with the Head Sexton
- Maintain all fitness equipment
- Develop and adhere to budget
- Prepare program reports with facility usage, revenue generated and participant numbers
- Attend weekly staff meetings
