Rabbi Jamie Hyams

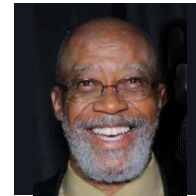

Imam Mughid Ramadan

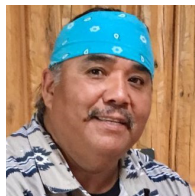
