SHARE TESTING RESULTS WITH FAMILIES	
	Provide Star Parent Reports Ensure every family of tested children receives their Star Parent Report. This letter comes in both English and Spanish, offering valuable insights into their child's performance.
ANALYZE STUDENT READINESS	
	Print the Star Diagnostic Report Review individual diagnostic and skill information for each student. Focus on the following: • Strands & Substrands: Understand strengths and weaknesses. • Percentile Ranks (PR): » Below 10 PR: Intensive intervention needed. » Below 25 PR (Yellow/Red): Targeted intervention required. » 25-39 PR (Blue): Additional support with general instruction may be beneficial. • Color Coding: Graphical representation helps identify performance levels.
PLAN PERSONALIZED INSTRUCTION	
	Utilize FELDS (Florida Early Learning Developmental Standards) Use the Florida Early Learning and Developmental Standards (FELDS) in conjunction with the Diagnostic Report to tailor activities for both individual and group instruction.
	Access the <u>Activity Plans for the Preschool Classroom</u> aligned with the Florida Early Learning and Developmental Standards (FELDS), which include developmentally appropriate, hands-on activities to support learning.
