 - Day 2: 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- K-5 classroom teachers in Florida's public and charter schools
- VPK lead teachers and aides who work at a VPK contracted provider

WHERE?

- Sessions are scheduled in counties across the state and organized into VPK - K, 1 - 2 and 3 - 5 grade bands.
- Each school district, including charter districts and lab schools, has been assigned a regional location. See back page.
