This same student is now participating in special area subjects for the first time without assistant support. Over in 5th grade, strategic co-planning and co-teaching is employed to keep students focused and engaged. Co-teachers Marissa Beatrice and Jill Martin have implemented math centers as one way to provide differentiated instruction. The 6th grade team, along with Chrissy Kelly and special educator, Carolyn Collins, have been collaborating with Ruth Divver, to accommodate social studies assessments so that students can express their learning through multiple means.
