Cara Weinberg, the Inclusion Facilitator for Oak Park Elementary, created a clipboard that contains a visual schedule, a reward system, and visual reminders for several students in the primary grades. Before an unpreferred activity begins, students are asked to choose a reward from the back of the clipboard and place it on the front as a visual cue. Rewards are individualized based on student interest and motivation. Cara discovered what would motivate each child by completing interest inventories with students and their families. Special education assistant, Deb Michael, has consistently implemented the plan with students. Since implementing this technique, students have shown great improvement with work completion and engagement.
