The Newfoundland and Labrador Crime Stoppers' Police and Peace Officer of the Year Awards (POYA) is an annual program which accepts nominations of police and peace officers working in the province and who perform above and beyond the call of duty both on the job and in their community.

Nominations are now being accepted in confidence from police or peace officers as well as members of the general public and community organizations for:

- Police Officer of the Year Royal Canadian Mounted Police
- Police Officer of the Year Royal Newfoundland Constabulary
- Peace Officer of the Year employed for the preservation and maintenance of the public peace or for the service or execution of civil processes (i.e. Municipal Enforcement Officers, Fishers & Wildlife Officers, Sherriff's, etc.).

In preparing your nomination please read the following carefully:

- A complete nomination package MUST include a completed nomination form and a nomination summary and/or letters of reference;
- Nominators may nominate more than one officer however you **MUST** complete a separate nomination for each person;
- A nomination summary of <u>no more than three</u> pages should accompany each nomination package and should specifically address:
 - His/her professionalism and dedication to public service and benefit to others;
 - His/her contribution to community, region and/or province;
 - His/her demonstrated leadership and describe outstanding accomplishments on the job;
 - His/her performance of special acts or services in the public interest; and,
 - Any other information you may wish to supply to best describe why you are nominating this person.
- Past nominations can be resubmitted for consideration.

The deadline for nominations is on or before end of day 20 March 2017 and the awards will be presented on Friday, 19 May 2017 at an awards ceremony at the Manuels River Hibernia Interpretation Centre, Conception Bay South, NL.
