Bible Study Hour is at 9:45 am.

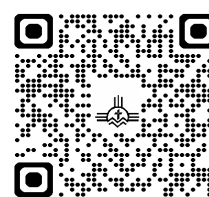

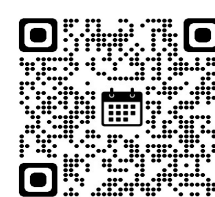

WE BELIEVE... THE LORD'S SUPPER

(Communion) is a miracle in bread and wine! In the Lord's Supper, we receive Christ's body and blood for the forgiveness of sins and the strengthening of faith in, with, and under the bread and wine. This is the most important thing in the Sacrament.

Matthew 26:26-28

If you believe what Christ says about His Supper and share the beliefs we have in this congregation of Christians, you are encouraged to join us for Communion. If not, please use this time for prayer and reflection upon God's love for you.

We then invite you to speak with the Pastor or Lay Minister about how you too, can share in this wonderful gift. If you have difficulty going forward to the rail and would like to be communed in your pew, let the Pastor, Lay Minister, or Usher know of your request.

The cups in the center of each communion tray are filled with grape juice if you prefer this option.
