If the parent or legal guardian submits the entry, the essay must nonetheless be entirely the work of the student.

All the entries will be judged and five new "My Favorite Teachers" will be chosen.

The five winning teachers will be featured on Good Morning Quad Cities (4:30 a.m. – 7 a.m.) and News 8 at 5PM during the week of March 12 - 16, 2018.
