



Senior Friendly Care (sfCare) and the Senior Friendly Seven (SF7): building more connected care for frail seniors

In March 2017, 400 healthcare providers from across Ontario attended the Senior Friendly ACTION Collaborative Showcase to share their work and meet with key experts in the care of older adults. In 2018 the Senior Friendly Care conference will connect providers from across the continuum of care to explore the idea of the SF7 – the seven most promising areas for senior friendly inter-sectoral care.
