- ◆ **Six** Senior Scholarships of **\$500 each** for LBSS students continuing their education at a 2- or 4-year accredited college, vocational or technical school, or other accredited post-secondary program.
- ◆ **Four** Senior Scholarships of **\$250 each** for LBSS students continuing their education at a 2- or 4-year accredited college, vocational or technical school, or other accredited post-secondary program.

Applicant Qualifications:

- ◆ Applicant must be a Senior at Lake Braddock Secondary School
- ◆ Applicant must have a current PTSA Membership
 - Student membership is \$5.00 and you can join at www.lbssptsa.org prior to applying for this scholarship.
- ◆ Applicant must plan to continue their education at a 2- or 4-year accredited college, vocational or technical school, or other accredited post-secondary program for the school year beginning in Fall 2019.
- ◆ Applicant must have demonstrated responsibility, character, and leadership during their high school career
 - PTSA Scholarships will be awarded to students who, among other traits, demonstrate responsibility, character, and leadership during their high school career.
 - For example, students participate in school clubs or school sports teams, support family goals, are active in non-profit organizations, or volunteer in the community.
 - Students may also have participated as student representatives for the LBSS PTSA.
