North Country youth don't drink alcohol.

That's important.

North Country high school students participating in the 2019 Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS) reported that in the 30 days prior to the survey*:



70.7%
DID NOT



82.8%
DID NOT binge drink



95.9%
DID NOT
drink & drive

Alcohol is involved in the deaths of approximately 3,500 young people under age 21 each year.

Youth who use alcohol are also more likely to use drugs, get bad grades, get injured, engage in sexual activity, make bad decisions, and have health problems such as depression and anxiety.
