RACE & BOAT CONSTRUCTION RULES

1. Boats must be made of biodegradable paper or cardboard and be low cost. Paper or cardboard material may be waxed.
2. Up to **one (1) board foot of lumber** may be used per crew person in constructing the boat. The wood is to be used for framing, stiffening, or fastening cardboard. **One (1) board foot** is a piece of wood measuring:
 - a. 1" thick x 1" wide x 12' long; or
 - b. 3/4" thick x 3/4" wide x 21' 6" long; or
 - c. 1/2" thick x 1/2" wide x 48' long
3. Fasteners may be rope, string, staples, nails, bolts, or tape (duct, masking, scotch).
4. Glue, paint, roofing cement, sealers, etc used in boat construction must be certified as water based by the boat sponsor.
5. **No epoxy** of any kind may be used. **No plastic or oil based paint** may be used.
6. Boats will be available for inspection by the race judge 30 minutes prior to the race start time.
7. Boat crew members must wear life jackets at all times and be in/on the boat at the finish line.
