We are looking for talented and dedicated individuals to fill the following roles in the Foundation:

- **Project Coordinator** *Full-time:* The Project Coordinator is responsible for the coordination of after-school programming through YMWIC's After-School Programs. The Site Coordinator will work with families, community partners and school administrators to facilitate implementation of workshops and activities for youth and their families. Program delivery includes, but is not limited to, improving the odds of youth's chances of going to and graduating from college. General delivery includes strong and effective communication with partners and staff and student supervision.
- Summer Educator June through July, 2023: We are seeking Education students and graduates to participate as teachers for our six-week STEAM Camps. The Summer Educator is responsible for administering curriculum for YMWIC K-12 camps and programs within the Delaware Valley, and should instill an excitement about Science, Technology, Engineering, Math, Language Arts and Art topics in Scholars. Summer curriculum includes a science project and field trips.
- Tutors Part-time: YMWIC is looking for College Student Volunteer Tutors for our 2022-2023 After-School Pre-Scholarship Programs. Two-hour on-site tutoring opportunities are available between 4:00PM and 6:00PM for YMWIC Scholars in 3rd through 12th Grades, at each of our seven School District Chapters in Chester Upland, Coatesville Area, Norristown Area, Phoenixville, Upper Darby, West Chester Area and William Penn.
