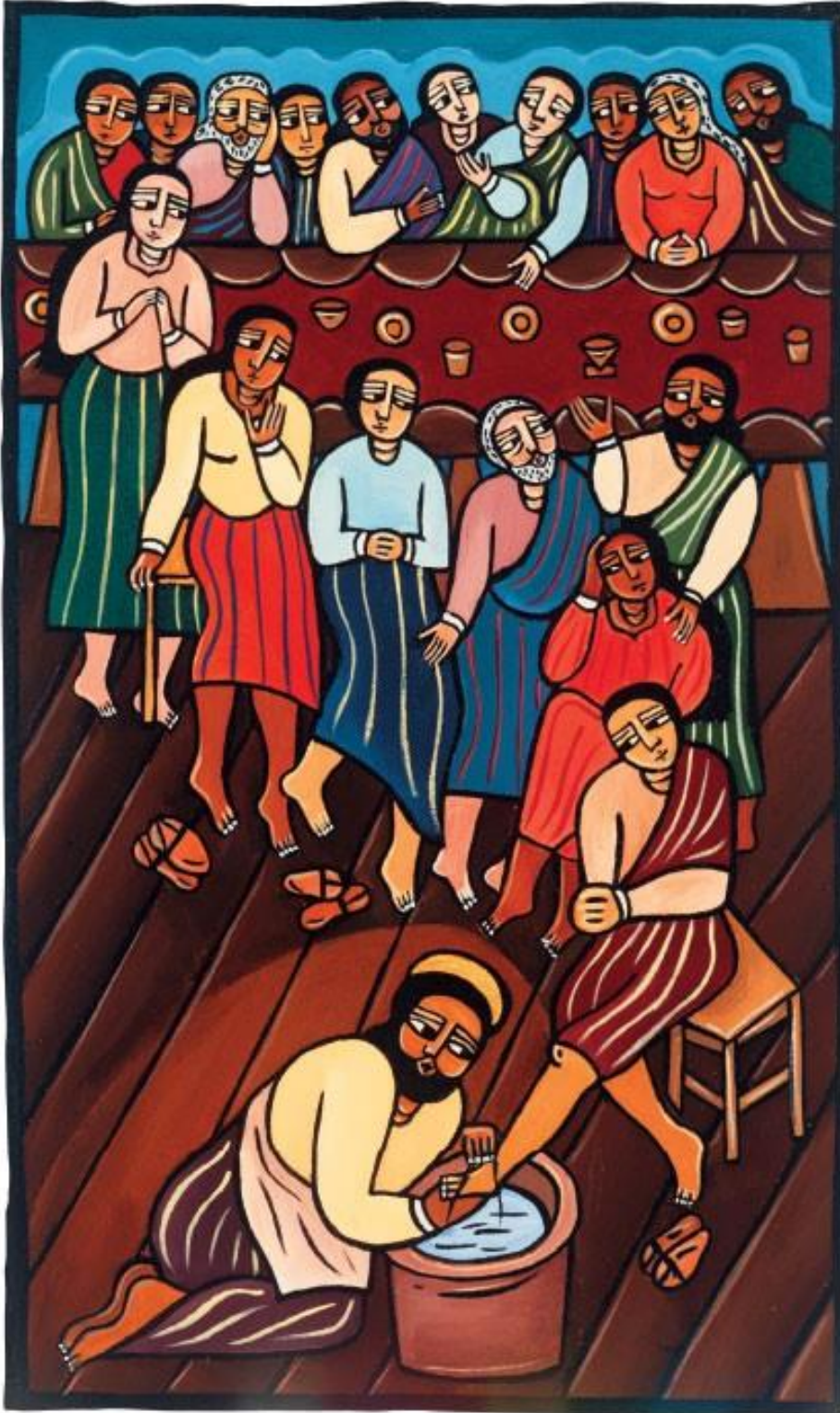

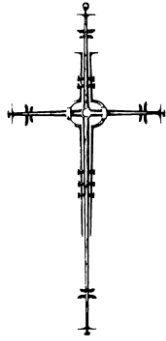

Volunteer Opportunities

Woods Church Backpack Buddies program at Annapolis Middle School will be starting in October 2021. Of the 1000 children attending AMS, over 700 are part of the FARMS Program. Government food programs are sending food home Monday through Friday, but there is still a need to assist the neediest of these children with weekend food.

This year we are not allowed to have the traditional program, where we meet the children and give the food out to them, but we will be packing 75 food bags every week and providing gift cards for key holidays and birthdays. These will be passed to the school staff for distribution. A donation of \$250 will feed a child every weekend for 10 months! That's just \$25 a month.
