Summary of New York "Micro-Cluster" Strategy

- 1. These zones are more targeted than NY State regional monitoring NY uses granular data to pinpoint epicenters of viral outbreaks in neighborhoods and smaller areas.
- 2. More calibrated and focused response regarding shutdowns attempt to include actions that may be shown by contact tracing data as driving viral spread.

3. Focus Zone Distinctions:

Geographic area has 10 or more new daily cases per 100,000 residents on 7-day average AND:

Red: 7-day rolling average positivity above 4% for 10 days

Orange Warning: 7-day rolling average positivity above 3% for 10 days

Yellow Precautionary: 7-day rolling average positivity above 2.5% for 10 days

ALSO

<u>Orange Buffer Zone</u>: An Orange Zone area can be put in place primarily in densely populated urban areas as a tight buffer zone around a Red Zone micro-cluster. The purpose:

- 1. to restrict activity to prevent further spread from Red Zone area;
- 2. to provide a defined geographic area where metrics can be monitored daily to ensure COVID is not spreading beyond the Red Zone.

<u>Yellow Buffer Zone</u>: A Yellow Zone area can be put in place as a broader buffer area to ensure COVID outbreak is not spreading into the broader community. The purpose:

- 1. to restrict some activity to help prevent further spread from Red and/or Orange Warning Zone area;
- 2. to provide a larger defined geographic area where metrics can be monitored daily to ensure COVID is not spreading beyond the Red Zone or Orange Warning Zone.
