Michigan Works! The programs Michigan Works offers are not loans, so will not need to be repaid.

Even those who are currently enrolled in classes, but could still use financial assistance are encouraged to apply, as well as those who have been denied the Future for Frontliners Program, the Pell Grant, or those with out-of-district tuition.

Michigan Works has helped many job seekers in the region further their education and start new careers in welding, truck driving, law enforcement, utility lineman, mechanics, HVAC, nursing, medical assistant, construction, manufacturing, and more.
