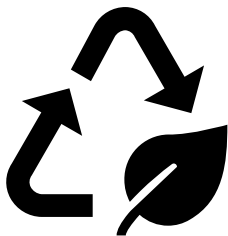
We're looking for community involvement for this year's Earth Day Litter Clean-Up. An appreciation lunch will follow at noon.

Safety Tips for Clean Up:

- 1. Wear bright colors, dress for the weather, and wear comfortable footwear.**
- 2. Wear gloves.**
- 3. Work and walk along streets in the opposite direction of traffic. If alongside a high traffic street, use a spotter or traffic cones.**
- 4. If involving children, we strongly advise staying away from the roadway edge and making sure they know what needles look like and DO NOT touch them.**
- 5. Properly dispose of the trash collected.**
- 6. Wash your hands or use disinfectant after handling trash pickup.**
- 7. DO NOT PICK UP & Notify Dispatch (603-942-8284): sharp objects, needles and syringes, hazardous waste, abandoned barrels, chemical containers, unidentifiable containers, bulging or dented containers, containers leaking unknown substances, propane cylinders, gas cans, oil or antifreeze, paint cans, pesticide or herbicide containers, automotive batteries, weapons, narcotics, or dead animals.**
