

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# About iPlatform


iPlatform was initially launched in 2019 in response to ESSA (Every Student Succeeds Act) reporting requirements which the Department expanded in an initiative for full data transparency and to foster a data-use culture across our communities. The new version establishes a unified new technology platform for all of the Department's data tools which is the groundwork for further tool integration and seamless reporting capabilities. Enhanced dashboard interactivity and a consistent look and feel as well as multiple new features make this version a welcome addition to the available data tools offering.

## iReport: The school and district report card


iReport is a great source to get a quick snapshot of a particular school or district and includes year-over-year information as well. It includes school and district enrollment profiles, student achievement and growth, college and career readiness, educator profiles, school environment and financial data as well as a whole set of other information.

## iExplore: Detailed analysis across all schools

iExplore includes multiple interactive dashboards that allow users to conduct an advanced analysis of a given indicator across all schools. It is a great resource for more in-depth analysis and data correlations to aid with decision making. iExplore is currently driven by 30 indicators for all schools and districts with many more indicators planned for future releases. The upgraded version of iExplore brings new features like downloading the data for any indicator across multiple years as well as a complete data dictionary for all indicators.
