We are the oldest continuously operating Black Chamber in the United States

On October 2, 1996 the Dallas Black Chamber of Commerce established a charitable subdivision the Dallas Black Chamber of Commerce Business Development Corporation (DBC-BDC).

In May of 2018 the Board of the DBC-BDC renamed the Corporation to the

“Dallas Black Chamber Center For Excellence”

to better reflect the focus and purpose of the organization.





The Purposes for which the corporation is organized and to be operated are exclusively

- charitable,
- literary,
- educational and
- scientific

within the meaning of section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws and under laws of the state of Texas.



The corporation's specific activities shall include, but shall not be limited to, the promotion, sponsorship and coordination of economic development in the Dallas/Fort Worth Consolidated Metropolitan Statistical Area (CMSA) by the following means:

(1) to encourage, foster and promote the renovation, construction, rehabilitation and establishment of economic development facilities and related infrastructure facilities within the Dallas/Fort Worth Consolidated Metropolitan Statistical Area (CMSA);



- (2) to promote job creation within the Dallas/Fort Worth Consolidated Metropolitan Statistical Area and economic redevelopment by encouraging the relocation of business, including industrial businesses, to property located in the Dallas/Fort Worth Consolidated Metropolitan Statistical Area;
- (3) to promote tourism in the Dallas/Fort Worth Consolidated Metropolitan Statistical Area;
- (4) to provide market research, relocation support and other activities designed to encourage the economic expansion of, and relieve deterioration of property located in, the Dallas/Fort Worth Consolidated Metropolitan Statistical Area;
- (5) to assist in activities intended to encourage the elimination of prejudice.


