

ProMedica Fostoria Community Hospital Foundation Awards Healthcare Scholarships

FOSTORIA, Ohio, June 12, 2019 – ProMedica Fostoria Community Hospital Foundation recently awarded \$9,550 in scholarships to 15 local students studying for degrees in healthcare. The scholarships were awarded on behalf of three scholarship funds administered by the hospital's Foundation Board. Former physicians, nurses and their families established the funds to encourage students to pursue a career in healthcare.

Additionally, nine scholarships were awarded from the J.A. Murray Memorial Scholarship Fund, which supports clinical and other hospital-based professionals.
