We are meeting (marshalling) at 925 N. College Ave. at 9:06 AM.

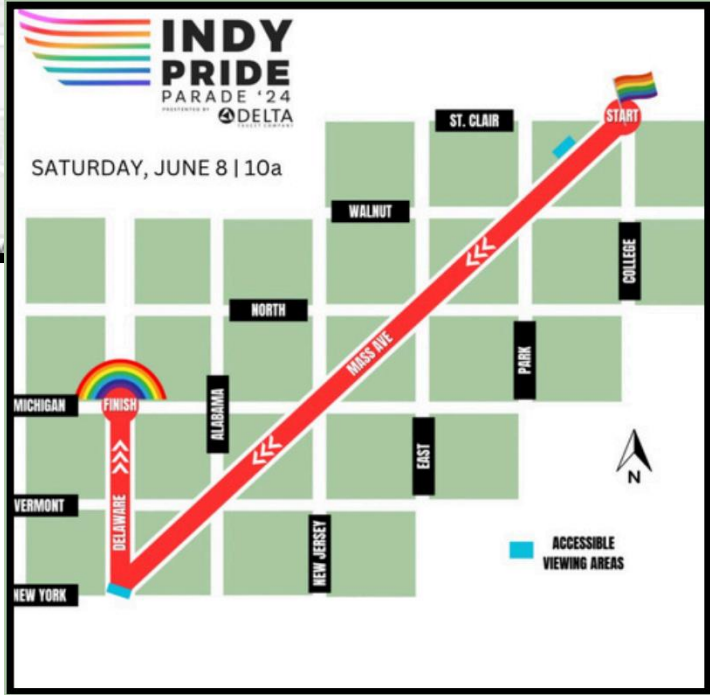
We march Southwest on Massachusetts Ave. to Delaware St., then turn to march to Delaware and Michigan.

Please Remember the Following things:

1. Please arrive at the Meeting/Marshalling point NO LATER THAN 9:06 AM. Earlier is better! Amy Sell & others will be waiting there to help us assemble.
2. Please wear a United Methodist Church T-shirt if you have one. If you do NOT have a UM Church shirt, consider wearing a brightly colored shirt (or Rainbow).

3. This is a long walk. It will be hot and we will be walking slowly. Be Prepared!

- a. Wear Comfortable Shoes.
- b. Bring and use Sunscreen.
- c. Wear a hat for Sun Protection.
- d. Consider bringing water to keep you hydrated.



4. Park between the start and finish of the Parade if you can. We gather at 10th and College Ave. and end at Delaware and Michigan St. (see map). There is a \$25 parking/shuttle arrangement through Gate Ten. Tickets are available at <https://www.affordableindyeventparking.com>



5. Bring your own sign! Consider messages of Welcome and Love (e.g., “All means All”, “God Loves You and so does the United Methodist Church”, etc.), or signs that identify your home church or that you are United Methodist. You can also bring Rainbow flags, or brightly colored streamers or bandanas to wave.
6. Be prepared to share the love with the people watching the parade. You are in the Parade to show the love of Christ that is present at United Methodist Churches. Don’t be shy, reach out, be responsive to onlookers.
