



Limited Reopening to Begin June 21

Please Register to Attend 8:30 a.m. Service

Beginning Sunday, June 21 we will restart our 8:30 a.m. Sunday service, pending a two-week decline in the number of new cases of COVID-19 in Marion County and the surrounding counties.

With your input from our recent survey, the Worship and Arts team has prepared protocols and modifications to ensure we do this as safely as possible. Attendance is voluntary. The responsibility for compliance to our guidelines lies with each worshiper.

We will continue to offer a live-streamed worship service at 11 a.m. with limited staff and music and no worshippers as we have been doing each week on our website, NorthChurchIndy.com. Further updates will be posted in this newsletter, our website, NorthNet, Facebook and Twitter.

Here are a few things you'll want to know about the 8:30 a.m. service:

- You'll need to register to attend this service to help us keep the attendance to approximately 50 people. You can register by contacting Jennifer Harrington, our administrative assistant, at **JHarrington@NorthChurchIndy.com** or **(317) 536-0789**. When making a reservation please include: the names of the people in your party, your phone number, and your email address. You'll receive a confirmation email that includes what time we'd like you to arrive to aid social distancing. Registration will be on a first-come, first-served basis.
- The deadline to register is noon each Friday.
- You'll be required to provide your own face mask and wear it when you're in the building, including during the service. A limited number of masks will be available for those who don't have one.
- There will be no congregational singing at this time.
- Entrance to the building will be through the west entry only.
- The only restrooms to be used are those adjacent to the community room.
- Ushers will seat and dismiss you similar to a wedding to aid social distancing.
- There will be no hospitality hour or a physical passing of the peace.

- Hand sanitizers and facial tissue will be available. All hymnals, Bibles, note cards, pew pads and pencils will be removed from the pews.
- Collection plates won't be passed. Instead, you may deposit your offerings before or after the service through offering boxes located in the sanctuary.
- You're asked to not visit in the west entry but to wait until you are in the parking lot to hold conversations at safe distances.
- Persons 65 and older and those who have preexisting health problems are encouraged to continue to only worship via the live stream at 11 a.m.

We are committed to safety but anxious to get back to in-person worship, even on this limited basis. We look forward to seeing you soon!
