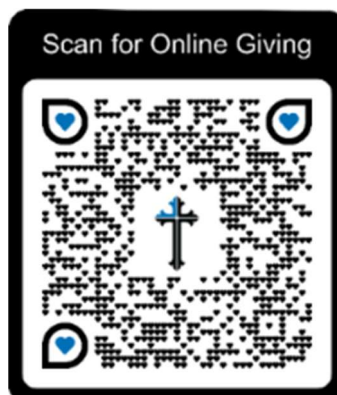
*Let Me Hide Myself In Thee*

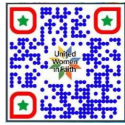
