

OZ Budget Notes for the June 2021 Congregational Meeting

A budget is a *best guess* of how much our income will be and where it will come from, and a *projection* of how we will spend that income. It is not set in stone, and it does not tie our hands if changes are necessary or desirable. It is an exercise in understanding and controlling our financial situation.

How to Read the Budget:

- Page 1 has all the INCOME, categorized by source (across the top) and use (down the side).
 - Where a project has multiple sources of income, they are totaled in the last column.
 - All the income from a particular source is totaled in the bottom row.
 - E.g., we project that the High Holiday Seats Appeal (donations) will bring in \$25,900.
 - E.g., we expect our endowments to contribute \$81,780 to our operations.
- Pages 2-3 have all the EXPENSES, categorized and organized the same way.
- The “Transfer In” income and “Transfer Out” expense shift funds from one project to another. The “Carry-over In” income and “Carryover Out” expenses shift unspent endowment funds from one year to the next. These are internal bookkeeping and do not change our financial picture.
- To the right, page 3 also gives the net (income minus expenditures) for every project and compares these with the projections for the current year.
- Projects of the synagogue that are entirely supported by special endowments are not included in the annual budget.

Notes:

- The 2021-2022 budget includes ***no significant program changes*** from the last two years. As page 3 shows, the numbers are close to the projected numbers for the current year.
- The **major differences between the current year and next year** are highlighted on page 3.
 - The cost of the “Office and Board” project drops because we are applying a large portion of the PPP loan to this line to balance the budget overall.
 - The cost of the “Facilities” project increases because our maintenance and utilities are returning to normal amounts after the pandemic.
 - The cost of the “Clergy” project increases because more of the Cantor’s salary is covered by the operating budget.
- Our total 2021-2022 budget is \$1,286,880. Of this, the largest portion (73%) is Salaries and Benefits.
- Thanks to the generous donors to the ***Imagine Campaign*** and the PPP loans from the Federal Government, we have balanced both the current year’s budget (which closes June 30) and the 2021-2022 budget. The Imagine Campaign income (\$47,528) is shown in the 3rd column of page 1, on its own line. The PPP funds that we are applying to operations (approx. \$115,000) are included with other general income in the “Office and Board Program Income”, which is highlighted.
- Although we have two successive balanced budgets, we have not solved our tendency to spend more than we take in. But at least we now have time to find ways to increase our income and reduce our expenditures.
