A new **Social Justice Committee** will work to integrate and coordinate social justice activities of the Shuk, G'MaCH, Social Action, Rabbi Amy, Cantor Steve, and Hebrew School/Full Circle initiatives to build awareness of our commitment to social justice, increase community participation and integrate more young families into our work together. **Please join us.**

The **Family Engagement Task Group** will begin to organize supportive membership engagement teams to work on supporting practices and policies that foster welcoming within our young families, but also across our entire OZ Family. **Please join us.**

The **Physical and Digital Home Task Group** will continue to work with the Preschool and the Hebrew School to facilitate short-term needs based on their year over year growth, while also beginning to plan for a larger renovation to modernize our building. **Please join us.**
