

FROM THE TREASURER

Hi all -

First of all, thanks to everyone who is helping the Imagine 2025 groups – those groups are in my view very important to the future of OZ!

For the regular report: On the balance sheet as of our fiscal year-end, June 30, 2021, OZ had \$351k in cash, up from \$117k as of June 30 last year, partly due to our *second* loan of \$163k from the federal Paycheck Protection Program, and partly due to major gifts from our “Imagine 2025” fundraising campaign (those gifts are moved to our Restricted Funds bank account to be released as needed and authorized by the board).

The outstanding long-term loan balances were \$129k on the \$200k kitchen loan, and \$184k on the \$212k endowment loan, paid down from \$177k and \$198k, respectively, at the end of last June. Our operating results are break-even for the fiscal year, about the same as last year’s \$1k for the same period. We used \$53k of the second PPP loan, plus another \$53k from our Imagine 2025 Fund to balance the budget, for a total deficit of a little over \$106k in the absence of those funds. We expect the PPP loan to be completely forgiven by the federal government, and we will use the remainder of the \$163k to help balance next year’s loss, if any. The Board authorized a donation from the Shalom Shuk to its designated charity of 10% of the Shuk’s net profit for last year, which would mean a donation of \$1,318.

NOTE: We do need everyone to return their pledge form! And we thank you very much for your pledge!
