NEW Federal Law Increases Unemployment Money

CARES Act¹ Unemployment Benefits Available² to You

The CARES Act provides a **boost** in unemployment benefits, which means more money is available to you if you otherwise qualify because the CARES Act:

- Increases your normal benefit by **\$600/week through July 31, 2020**, meaning you may get \$600 per week in addition to whatever you would have received under existing state laws;
- **expands** the money payment duration **from 26 weeks to 39 weeks**;
- eliminates the waiting period of one-week so you can **get the money immediately**.

The CARES Act **temporarily makes money available to you even if you did not qualify before**, if you:

(1) are normally not eligible for unemployment because you are self-employed or you are an independent contractor for example, or you have exhausted your unemployment payments; and you

(2) can truthfully certify that you are able and available to work, but unable, or unavailable to work or telework because you:

- are diagnosed with COVID-19, or experiencing symptoms or seeking a diagnosis of COVID-19; or
- have a member of your household that has been diagnosed with COVID-19; or
- are providing care to a family member with COVID-19; or
- have primary caregiving responsibility for a child who is unable to attend school due to COVID-19; or
- cannot reach your place of work because of a quarantine on advice of a health care provider to self-quarantine; or
- has become a breadwinner after the head of household has died from COVID-19; or
- has had to quit working as a direct result of COVID-19; or
- has a work location that is closed as a direct result of a COVID-19 declared emergency.
