

## TRANSFORMED BY THE RESURRECTION

Alleluia! Christ is risen! Imagine the flood of emotions that Mary of Magdala must have experienced on that first Easter morning. Grieving and yet determined to visit the place where Jesus' body had been laid, Mary would have been stunned to find the tomb empty. Imagine Simon Peter and the other disciple who, upon hearing Mary's announcement, ran to see for themselves. On Easter, we hear the story of Jesus' resurrection as though for the first time, through the account of Mary's discovery and the testimony of Peter who powerfully shared Christ's Paschal Mystery. We, too, have come to believe through their faithful witness. We are called to seek what is above, turn away from sin, and live as people who are forever transformed by the Good News of Jesus' resurrection.

## STEP OUT IN FAITH

Mary ran to tell Simon Peter and the other disciple that the tomb was empty. No doubt confused and concerned, Peter and the other disciple set aside whatever fear might have occurred to them and ran to see the tomb for themselves. We do not always understand God's ways. We too are confused at times; our lives are marked by moments of uncertainty, and at times we are afraid. We can learn from Mary, Simon Peter, and the other disciple and step out in faith, trusting that we will find the Lord in the midst of the circumstances of our lives. When life gets complicated, as it often does, the best thing to do is step out, perhaps even run to the Lord!

## BEAR WITNESS

We may not have opportunities to address crowds of people and share the gospel with them. Still, we are called to bear witness to our faith in the ways that we are able, in word and in deed. We cannot share what we have not fully embraced ourselves, however. The Easter season is the perfect time to reflect on Christ's Paschal Mystery, the unfathomable love of Jesus who shows and shares God's love perfectly. Our Lord gave his life so that we might have life, and have it to the full. Christ's victory over sin and death is our victory, our promise of eternal life with God in the fullness of time. See in Christ's life, passion, death, and resurrection the sign of God's mercy. Let this Easter day be a moment in which you allow yourself to be touched by Christ's incredible, undying love. Then, renewed in faith, look for ways to bear witness to the mercy, forgiveness, compassion, and love of the Lord with others.

**St. Oliver's Vocation Ministry** Our mother Mary is the model and mother of vocations. She has responded better than any other to God's call. For this reason, it is quite fitting to seek her intercession as we pray to God to help us focus and encourage prayer for vocations and to have courage to listen and respond to God's calling. Our traveling statue of Our Lady of La Salette serves as a visible reminder for us to seek the intercession of Our Lady as we pray as a family, community or single person for vocations.



Go to our website and use the Sign-up Genius to sign up to take the statue home for a week. Pick up the statue on Sunday at the Mass you attend. During the week the host family is asked to make a special effort to pray together with an emphasis on an increase to vocations to the priesthood, religious life and marriage, as well as a clear understanding as to the vocation Christ is calling each family member. A book of prayers will accompany the statue.

**SPIRITUAL ADOPTION BEGINS MARCH 25** To help stop the anti-life push in The U.S. the late Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen encouraged the **spiritual adoption of an unborn child**. This is done by praying everyday *that this unknown child's life be spared from abortion and be allowed to live*. To help accomplish this, we recommend that families pray this prayer everyday from the feast of the Annunciation – March 25 through December. To make it very personal, **name the baby** you have spiritually adopted and pray with your children and/or grandchildren so they too can be praying for the soul of a baby in the womb. During our earthly life this spiritually adopted child will be known only to GOD but in the world to come it is hoped that we will meet the child whose life was spared by our prayers and spend eternal happiness with them.



## TRANSFORMADO POR LA RESURRECCIÓN

¡Aleluya! ¡Cristo ha resucitado! Imagina la avalancha de emociones que María de Magdala debió experimentar en esa primera mañana de Pascua. Afligida y, sin embargo, decidida a visitar el lugar donde se había puesto el cuerpo de Jesús, María habría quedado aturdida al encontrar la tumba vacía. Imaginen a Simón Pedro y al otro discípulo que, al escuchar el anuncio de María, corrió a ver por sí mismos. En la Pascua, escuchamos la historia de la resurrección de Jesús como si por primera vez, a través del relato del descubrimiento de María y del testimonio de Pedro que compartió poderosamente el misterio pascual de Cristo. Nosotros también hemos llegado a creer a través de su fiel testimonio. Estamos llamados a buscar lo que está arriba, apartarnos del pecado y vivir como personas que se transforman para siempre por la Buena Nueva de la resurrección de Jesús.

## MOVERNOS POR LA FE


