The Feast of Our Lady of La Salette October 19, 2020

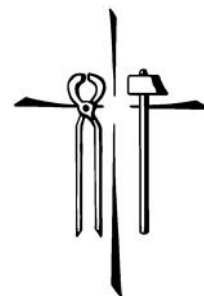
Our Lady of La Salette

In 1846, at La Salette in France, the Blessed Mother appeared to two children. Speaking to them, she told them to “make known to all my people” her message. Inspired by Mary’s call for reconciliation with God, the Missionaries of La Salette were founded in 1852 as “ministers of religion” to be “faithful dispensers of the mysteries of God.” Their charism focuses on Reconciliation and the Eucharist. Today, the Missionaries of La Salette wear many hats—from caring for the spiritual needs of visitors to the shrines and members of parish communities to serving as chaplains, teachers, youth ministers, and counselors. The Province of Mary, Mother of the Americas, has over 200 members serving in the United States and Canada, as well as in Argentina and Bolivia, working together with bishops, clergy, parishioners, pilgrims, and others throughout North America and the mission region in South America. Reflective common prayer, celebration of the Eucharist, and faith sharing are essential to achieving the La Salette mission to make this message of reconciliation known to all people.



The Hammer and Pincers

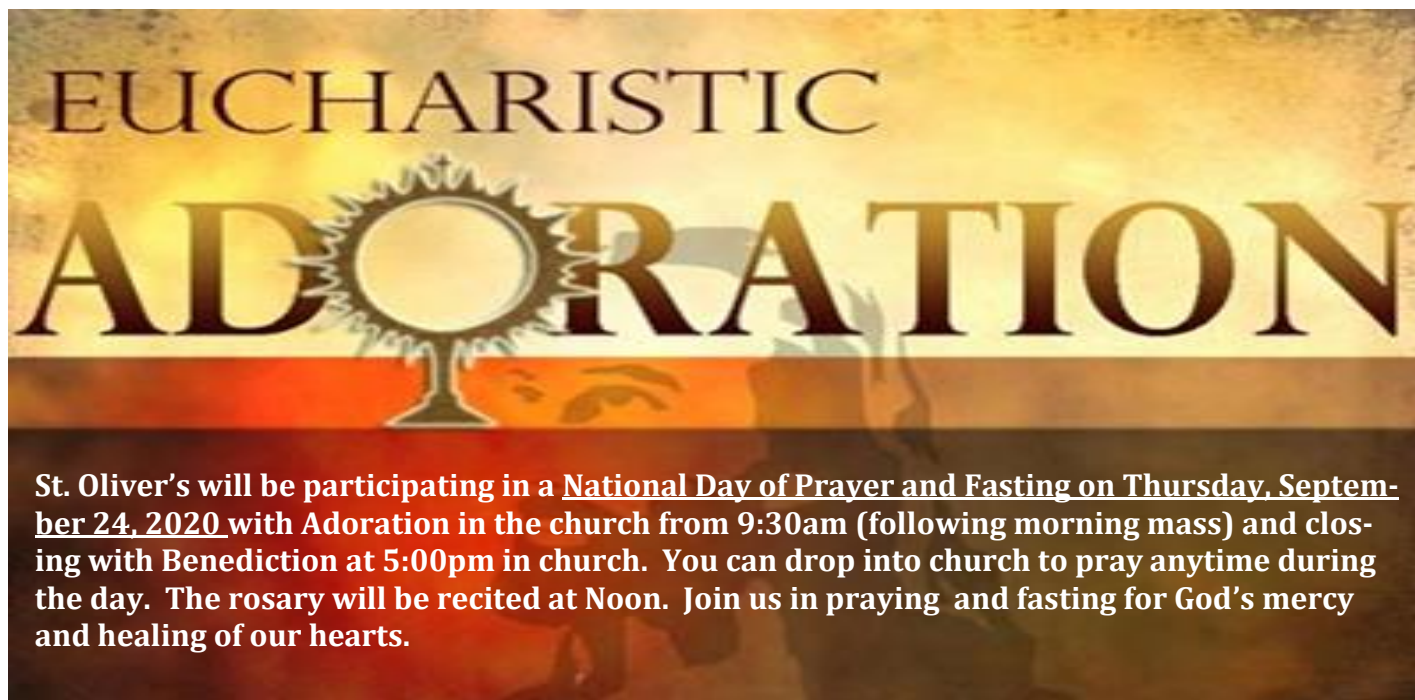
The La Salette Crucifix, with its hammer and pincers, was first worn by Our Lady on September 19, 1846 at the apparition at La Salette in France. The hammer on the crucifix symbolizes the sins of humanity that put the nails into the hands of Jesus; the pincers symbolize the good actions we do which remove the nails from Jesus’ hands.



EUCCHARISTIC

Beginning on the First Friday in October, October 2, 2020 and continuing each First Friday of the month, we offer Adoration from 9:30am (following morning mass) to Noon. The Monstrance will be exposed in the church and all are welcome to stop by to pray. We hope many will take advantage of the Adoration on each First Friday and please remember to wear a mask.



NATIONAL DAY OF PRAYER AND FASTING, Thursday, September 24, 2020

The idea for the entire nation devoting a single day to prayer and fasting grew out of the weekly podcast series produced by ACTS XXIX, *You Were Born for This* with Fr. John Riccardo. An episode in mid-July about the need for courage in these times sparked a great response from listeners. While working on a follow-up episode, Fr. John was led to President Abraham Lincoln's Presidential Proclamations where Lincoln called for a day of fasting, prayer, and public humiliation. Mary Guilfoyle, ACTS XXIX Associate Director, also felt led in prayer to call for a day of prayer and fasting and urged that ACTS XXIX take the lead.

"This is not about politics or any particular social movement or even the November election," Fr. Riccardo cautions. "This is about asking for God's mercy on our nation and for the healing of our hearts—all of our hearts, starting with mine." His hope is that the entire country, Christians, Jews, Muslims, and all people of good will, would set September 24 aside as a true holy day, forego food until dinner, and pray for the conversion of hearts.

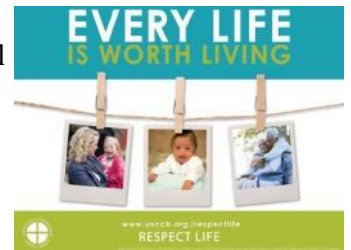

La fiesta de Nuestra Señora de La Salette 19 de septiembre de 2020

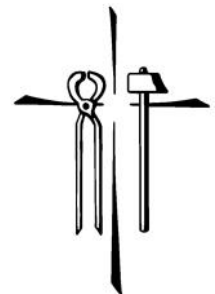
Nuestra Señora de La Salette

En 1846, en La Salette en Francia, la Santísima Madre se apareció a dos niños.

Hablando con ellos, les dijo que "den a conocer a todo mi pueblo" su mensaje. Inspirados por el llamado de María a la reconciliación con Dios, los Misioneros de La Salette fueron fundados en 1852 como "ministros de religión" para ser "fieles dispensadores de los misterios de Dios". La Provincia de María, Madre de las Américas, tiene más de 200 miembros que sirven en los Estados Unidos y Canadá, así como en Argentina y Bolivia, trabajando junto con obispos, clérigos, feligreses, peregrinos y otros en América del Norte y la región misionera. en Sur America. La oración común reflexiva, la celebración de la Eucaristía y el compartir la fe son esenciales para lograr la misión de La Salette de dar a conocer este mensaje de reconciliación a todas las personas.



El martillo y las tenazas El crucifijo de La Salette, con su martillo y sus tenazas, fue usado por primera vez por Nuestra Señora el 19 de septiembre de 1846 en la aparición en La Salette en Francia. El martillo en el crucifijo simboliza los pecados de la humanidad que pusieron los clavos en las manos de Jesús; las tenazas simbolizan las buenas acciones que hacemos que quitan los clavos de las manos de Jesús.

SUÉLTAME

En nuestra vida diaria, y en la oración y la adoración, nos encontramos con un Dios que no comprendemos completamente. A veces nos encontramos con un Dios misterioso y sorprendente, cuyas acciones y designios están más allá de nosotros, “tan alto como los cielos están sobre la tierra”. Nuestras lecturas de esta semana describen la confusión, la alegría y el desafío de este encuentro. Las lecturas nos invitan a “dejarnos ir”. Isaías nos invita a dejar de tratar de encajar a Dios en nuestras propias maneras cómodas de pensar. Pablo, sabiendo que podría enfrentar la muerte en cualquier momento, describe su alegría por haber dejado de intentar controlar su futuro. La parábola de Jesús en el Evangelio de Mateo nos desafía a dejar de en medio limitar la generosidad de Dios a los demás. Que nuestros encuentros con nuestro Dios misterioso pero digno de confianza transformen nuestros corazones y mentes, y profundicen nuestra confianza en Dios.

UN DIOS GENEROSO

La parábola del Evangelio de hoy identifica una tendencia fuertemente humana de creer que cada uno debe obtener lo que se merece. Si logramos más que otros, merecemos recibir más: más dinero, más privilegios, más honor. Y así anticipamos que Dios nos recompensará más libremente a aquellos que han hecho más por Dios.

Jesús dice que Dios hace las cosas de manera diferente. El salario de un día, en la historia es como el don de perdón y salvación, compartida igual y abundantemente con todos. Los trabajadores de tiempo completo se quejan diciéndole: “le pagas lo mismo que a nosotros que soportamos el peso del día y del calor”. Les molestaba que no les hayan pagado más que a los otros, rechazando aceptarlos como iguales. Jesús dice que en medio del pueblo de Dios no hay tal jerarquía. Independientemente de antecedentes o logros, podemos aceptar a todos como hermanos y hermanas, y alegrarnos en la generosidad de Dios para todos.

EL PRIMERO Y EL ÚLTIMO

En la parábola de hoy, había empleados que trabajaron todo el día y a los que les pagaron primero; ellos probablemente nunca hubieran conocido que los empleados que empezaron tarde su jornada habían recibido la misma paga y no habrían estado celosos. En la forma en que la historia se cuenta, tanto la justicia y la misericordia de Dios se revelan. El patrón dio un salario justo a los que trabajaron todo el día; y fue generosamente misericordioso con aquellos que trabajaron menos horas.

Cuando Jesús dice que “los últimos serán los primeros, y los primeros, los últimos”, él apunta hacia el Reino de Dios. Este es un reino donde la opresión termina y las divisiones entre las personas son sanadas. Dios trae justicia y misericordia al mundo que gravemente las necesita. En el libro del Apocalipsis, Jesús llama a “los primeros y los últimos”, el Alfa y el Omega. En Jesús, los primeros y los últimos se reúnen para sanar el mundo de Dios. Cuando trabajamos por justicia y mostramos misericordia, nos unimos en el ministerio sanador de Jesús.
