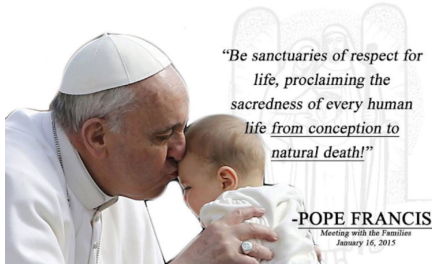

40 DAYS FOR LIFE FALL CAMPAIGN **SEPTEMBER 28 THROUGH NOVEMBER 6**

40 Days for Life is a focused pro-life national campaign with a vision to build up a culture of life through prayer and fasting, peaceful vigil at abortion clinics and community outreach. We at St. Oliver's have an opportunity to participate in this Fall Campaign **(Sept. 28 through Nov. 6)** along with other churches in our area to pray and be witnesses for life at the Planned Parenthood Clinic in Lawrenceville every Tuesday and Saturday during this

campaign period. Abortions are performed here every Tuesday and Saturday year round. We are encouraged to PRAY AND ACT in order to serve the people of God in support of a culture of LIFE. We are grateful that Roe v. Wade was overturned and the GA Heartbeat Law is now in effect. However, Lawrenceville's Planned Parenthood clinic is continuing to abort babies up to 6 weeks gestation so we are still needed to pray in front of the facility and offer help to women. We invite you to join us in this simple way of witnessing – it only takes our willingness. There's no better way to prepare for the Advent season than to make a sacrifice that saves precious lives. You can take part in this individually or involve your ministry to come out as a group to pray the Rosary on one of these days. There will be vigil volunteers at these Planned Parenthood clinics all day every **Saturday from 8:30am to 4pm, and Tuesday 8:30am until 6pm.** Stand with us for a short time on either of these days in this **40 Days Campaign.** Clinic address: **798 Lawrenceville Suwanee Rd. St. Francis of Assisi is the patron saint of animals and the environment. His feast day is October 4th.



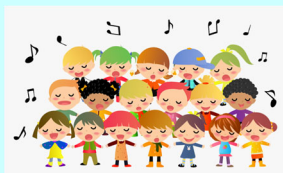

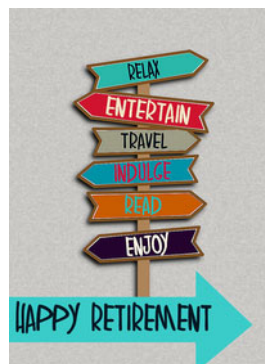

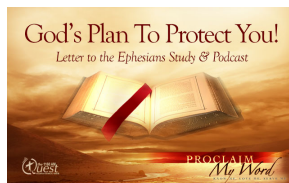
