As a Stanford student-athlete Tom Williams was a four-time varsity letterman, co-team captain, participated in two FBS bowl games; Aloha Bowl and Blockbuster bowl, academic all-Pac 10, District 8 Academic All-American and NACDA post-graduate scholarship recipient. Post-graduation Tom served as a graduate assistant for the legendary coach Bill Walsh.
