Operation Snowball, Inc. and the Board of Directors are accepting nominations for awards in categories that celebrate the many components of a successful OS program. Awards cover the 2016 – 2017 school year. *Nominations for all categories must be from a Chapter of good standing and up to date with accreditation for the current year.*

Outstanding Youth Leader

A youth currently involved in an Operation Snowball or Snowflake Chapter during the 2015-2016 school year and lives the alcohol and drug-free lifestyle that Operation Snowball represents. Nominees should be a role model for other students, demonstrate outstanding leadership in Snowball and/or Snowflake. Award is open to students 8th -12th grade.

Outstanding Adult Leader

An adult currently involved in either a Snowball or Snowflake Chapter. Nominees have shown their dedication and passion to Operation Snowball through their actions that demonstrate skills, knowledge and desire to elevate youth and adults through the Operation Snowball mission.

Outstanding Young Adult

A person who has graduated from high school and in their college years and displays a strong commitment to continued involvement in an Operation Snowball Chapter, either in their home community or in the community where they attend school or work. Nominees should display a strong commitment and lifestyle that is substance abuse-free does not engage in underage drinking. They are willing to stand up and be a voice for prevention and Operation Snowball.

Outstanding Snowball Chapter

An outstanding Chapter provides a continuing Snowball presence throughout the year. This Chapter demonstrates that it spreads the Snowball/Snowflake message through various campaigns, trainings, social events which model the mission of Operation Snowball while addressing the identified needs of their school and/or community. This Chapter demonstrates that adults and youth are working and playing together to create an environment where youth are skilled, motivated and empowered to influence their peers to make healthy decisions.

Outstanding Support from Community Organization or Business

This award recognizes local organizations, coalitions and/or businesses that have showed great support for Snowball or Snowflake by volunteering time, skills, money, and resources which lends to the success of the Chapter and the mission of Operation Snowball.
