## **Racing will go ahead at Cheltenham tomorrow, Saturday, 16 November and on Sunday, 17 November**

Following an inspection this afternoon, racing will go ahead on Saturday, 16 November and Sunday, 17 November. The Going is currently **SOFT, HEAVY IN PLACES**.

Both the third last hurdle and third last fence will be omitted to ensure that the horses run on the best possible surface in that area of the course.

The Cross Country course has also been given the all clear for Sunday, ahead of the rescheduled Glenfarclas Cross Country Chase, with the Aintree Fence (Fence 4,27) omitted.

Gates open on Saturday at 10.00am with the first race at 12.05pm. There will be eight races including the Ballymore Novices' Hurdle Race, which was originally scheduled for Friday.

Gates open on Sunday at 11.00am with the first race at 12.45pm. There will be seven races, and two pony races, including the Glenfarclas Cross Country Chase, which was also originally scheduled for Friday.

Please do be aware that many areas of the car parks are still very wet; Cheltenham Racecourse recommends using public transport or car sharing, if possible.

# BetVictor Gold Cup Facts & Figures

## Background information

First staged in 1960, the Grade Three BetVictor Gold Cup is one of Jump racing's most illustrious and valuable handicap chases and its history contains the names of some of the sport's finest horses.

The two and a half mile showpiece, first run under its present title in 2016, was known as the Paddy Power Gold Cup from 2003 to 2015, and the Thomas Pink Gold Cup from 2000 to 2002. Whitbread, under the Mackeson brand and then Murphys, backed the first 40 runnings from 1960. 2019 sees the 60th running.

## Multiple winners

There have been five dual winners – Fortria (1960 & 1962), Gay Trip (1969 & 1971), Half Free (1984 & 1985), Bradbury Star (1993 & 1994) and Cyfor Malta (1998 & 2002).

No horse has won the BetVictor Gold Cup more than twice.

## Most successful owner

The late David Johnson has been the most successful owner with seven successes – Challenger Du Luc (1996), Cyfor Malta (1998 & 2002), Lady Cricket (2000), Celestial Gold (2004), Our Vic (2005) and Great Endeavour (2011).

## Most successful trainer

Martin Pipe landed the spoils eight times before his retirement in April, 2006 – Beau Ranger (1987), Challenger Du Luc (1996), Cyfor Malta (1998 & 2002), Lady Cricket (2000), Shooting Light (2001), Celestial Gold (2004) and Our Vic (2005).

Of the current trainers, Nigel Twiston-Davies (1992 Tipping Tim, 2008 Imperial Commander, 2010 Little Josh and 2017 Splash Of Ginge) leads the way with four wins.

## Most successful jockey

The great Sir A P McCoy, the record-breaking 20-time champion Jump jockey who retired in April, 2015, has been the most successful rider in the race with four victories – Cyfor Malta (1998), Lady Cricket (2000), Shooting Light (2001) and Exotic Dancer (2006).

Among the current jockeys, Sam Twiston-Davies is the only multiple winner thanks to victories on Little Josh (2010) and Caid du Berlais (2014).

## Field size

The biggest field came in 1962 when 25 runners lined up, while the smallest was five in 1966. The current safety limit is 20.

## Betting

The longest-priced winners of the BetVictor Gold Cup have been 33/1 shots Chatham (1970) and Senor El Betrutt (1997). The biggest surprise since the latter won came in 2017 with 25/1 chance Splash Of Ginge.

Dunkirk (1965) has been the shortest-priced scorer at 11/10. Favourites have won 14 of the 59 runnings, a strike rate of 23.73 per cent, with Tranquil Sea being the most recent to succeed at 11/2 in 2009.

## Weights

Seven winners have defied top-weight – Fortria (1960 & 1962), Dunkirk (1965), Half Free (1984), Bradbury Star (1994), Cyfor Malta (2002) and Al Fero (2012). The top-weight, which was 12st 7lb when Dunkirk won in 1965, is now a maximum 11st 12lb.

Three winners have carried bottom weight of 10st – Red Candle (1972), Senor El Betrutt (1997) and The Outback Way (1999).

## BetVictor Gold Cup & Caspian Caviar Gold Cup

Seven horses have won both the BetVictor Gold Cup and the Caspian Caviar Gold Cup, which takes place over a similar distance at Cheltenham at The International in December. Of the seven winners, only three have achieved the feat in the same season – Pegwell Bay, Senor El Betrutt and Exotic Dancer. The seven winners of both races are:

## Did you know?

Imperial Commander is the only horse to win both the BetVictor Gold Cup (2008) and Magners Cheltenham Gold Cup (2010).

## Other facts about The November Meeting

The incomparable Arkle, winner of the Cheltenham Gold Cup from 1964 to 1966, made his British racecourse bow in the Honeybourne Chase on the Saturday of The November Meeting in 1962. It was a fantastic day for Arkle's trainer and jockey, Tom Dreaper and Pat Taaffe who, following Arkle's impressive victory by 20 lengths, went on to land what is now the BetVictor Gold Cup with Fortria.

Best Mate, also the winner of three Cheltenham Gold Cups in 2002, 2003 & 2004, gained his first success under Rules in Britain when taking The November Meeting bumper in 1999 and recorded the second chase win of his career at The November Meeting in 2000.

The 2010 Magners Cheltenham Gold Cup victor Imperial Commander won the 2008 BetVictor Gold Cup, while Long Run finished third to Little Josh in 2010 before going on to win the King George VI Chase and the 2011 Magners Cheltenham Gold Cup.

The 2003 Unibet Champion Hurdle victor Rooster Booster defied top-weight to win the Unibet Greatwood Hurdle in 2002. The 2001 Unibet Greatwood Hurdle winner, Westender, finished second to Rooster Booster in the 2003 Unibet Champion Hurdle, a feat mirrored in 2009/10 by Khyber Kim, who chased home Binocular at The Festival.

The November Meeting has only once been held at a different venue from Prestbury Park. A new drainage system was being installed at Cheltenham in 1976, so the then two-day meeting was switched to Lancashire's Haydock Park where Cancello became the only horse to win the BetVictor Gold Cup anywhere but Cheltenham.

**Leading owner Andy Stewart commemoates the great Big Buck's and helps Spinal Injuries Association with sponsorship at The November Meeting**



Andy Stewart, the leading racehorse owner, has generously sponsored a Listed handicap hurdle at The November Meeting at Cheltenham.

The £40,000 Listed Spinal Injuries Association Big Buck's Handicap Hurdle will take place over just short of three miles on day two of The November Meeting, Saturday, 16 November. The race recognises the important work of the Spinal Injuries Association and also commemoates the greatest staying hurdler of all-time, Big Buck's. Big Buck's created history by becoming the first four-time winner of what is now the Sun Racing Stayers' Hurdle at The Festival™ presented by Magners (2009, 2010, 2011 & 2012).

Big Buck's also broke Sir Ken's longstanding record set in the 1950s by winning 18 consecutive Jump races between January 1, 2009 and December 1, 2012 - a record which stood until surpassed by Altior in April this year. He has been with Mike and Lucy Felton since his retirement in 2014 and has hunted with the Blackmore and Sparkford Vale.

Andy Stewart has sponsored at Cheltenham previously, including backing the December Gold Cup between 2011 and 2013 and the Novices' Handicap Chase at The Festival™ in 2015. One of Andy's sons, Paul, suffered a severe spinal injury in a snowboarding accident in December, 2008, and was paralysed from the waist down. He was told initially by doctors that he would never walk again, but he proved them wrong and even went on to compete in triathlons.

Explaining his decision to sponsor once again at Cheltenham, Andy Stewart said: "My younger son Paul is disabled and I am very involved with the Spinal Injuries Association. The Spinal Injuries Association helped him enormously and he is able to get around and drive a car - he will be coming to Cheltenham on the Saturday of The November Meeting.

"I thought it would be a good idea to link up the Spinal Injuries Association with Big Buck's. Big Buck's won over hurdles at Cheltenham on New Year's Day in 2009 (the Unicoin Homes Handicap Hurdle), after he had fallen at the last when looking like he would he would win the Hennessy. Paul Nicholls then said we should go hurdling and I said 'You are bonkers!'. The horse he beat on New Year's Day was Don't Push It, who we gave over a stone to and of course went on to win the Grand National in 2010.

"Big Buck's then went on to four Ladbrokes World Hurdles as the race was known then, which was just amazing. He also won 18 consecutive races, which I know Altior has now passed with 19. I sent my congratulations to the connections of Altior by sending them 19 bottles of champagne, for which they were very appreciative.

"When Big Buck's won his 18th race in succession at Newbury in 2012, Simon Crisford came up to me and said he had Sheikh Mohammed on the phone to offer his congratulations - that is the kind of horse Big Buck's is. I also remember being with Andrew Lloyd-Webber and a boy came over wanting an autograph - we thought he wanted Andrew's but he said 'No, I want Mr Big Buck's!' and handed his pen to me!

"I have owned 200 or so horses during my lifetime but Big Buck's is so special - he gets more Christmas cards than the whole of my family put together and is still so well known."

Stewart is hoping to be represented in the SIA Big Buck's Handicap Hurdle by As De Mee, trained by Paul Nicholls, who has the Randox Health Grand National as his ultimate aim this season.

Stewart continued: "I am hoping to run several horses at The November Meeting including As De Mee, who I own in partnership with Dame Judi Dench. The Grand National as his main target this year as he has already won over the big fences at Aintree.

"Dame Judi Dench will hopefully be coming and I am also trying to get Tony Bloom along - his Cesarewitch winner Stratum can run in the race if he can persuade Willie Mullins.

**"Any prize money my horses earn over the three days of The November Meeting will go to the Spinal Injuries Association.**

**"The November Meeting offers great exposure for the work of the Spinal Injuries Association and it is great that this race will be broadcast by ITV."**
