Festival Trials Day Media Guide

Introduction

This media guide contains previous results for all seven races, five of which have Graded status, on Festival Trials Day at Cheltenham, dating back to at least 1990 or when they were instituted.

Underneath each race result is a list of successful horses on the day who went on to win at The Festival™ presented by Magners at Cheltenham the same season.

In 2019, Frodon, Paisley Park and Siruh Du Lac all followed up their Festival Trials Day triumphs with success at The Festival, taking the G1 Ryanair Chase, G1 Stayers' Hurdle and G3 Brown Advisory & Merriebelle Stable Plate Handicap Chase respectively.

Frodon's success in the G1 Ryanair Chase was particularly notable, with his jockey Bryony Frost becoming the first female rider to win a G1 race over obstacles at The Festival.

There are detailed statistics for the G2 Cotswold Chase, won last year by Frodon, which often provides valuable pointers towards the G1 Magners Cheltenham Gold Cup, staged this year on Friday, 13 March.

The most successful trainers and jockeys on Festival Trials Day are also highlighted.

Accompanied children, aged under 18, are admitted **FREE** on Festival Trials Day, when the gates open at 10.30am, while there is also **FREE** official car parking.

Festival Trials day will feature Live music around the course from The Hipcats in the Club/Tattersalls enclosure. There will also be live music after racing from Lampa in The Centaur for Club/Tatts racegoers.

A variety of hand-picked boutiques will be available in the Shopping Village.

After racing Tattersalls Cheltenham will stage the January Sale. On offer at the January Sale will be a select group of winning and placed point to pointers and Jump horses in the Owners and Trainers marquee after racing on Festival Trials Day. The January Sale will be the first time a Sale has been conducted exclusively in the Tattersalls sponsored Owners and Trainers marquee at Cheltenham and will provide a luxurious environment for buyers to purchase their future winners.

Paddy Power Cotswold Chase – facts & figures

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The G2 Paddy Power Cotswold Chase was first run in 1980 as the Tote Double Chase with a total prize fund of £5,215. The race was abandoned in 1987, 1992 (frost), 1996 (frost and snow) and 2006 (frost - a replacement was run at Wincanton the following Thursday).

The contest has had ten sponsors since inception: Tote Double Chase (1980-84), Holsten Distributions Chase (1985-87), Charterhouse Mercantile Chase (1988-92), Timeform Hall of Fame Chase (1993-94), Pillar Property Investments Chase (1995-2005), HBLB Cotswold Chase (2006), Letheby & Christopher Chase (2007-09), Argento Chase (2010-2014) and BetBright (2015-2019). Paddy Power takes over the sponsorship this year.

The race held Grade Two status for the first time in 1999 and has a total prize fund of £100,000 in 2020.

FIELD SIZE

The highest number of runners to line up was 10 (2013), while three took part in 1982 and 1988.

MULTIPLE WINNERS

See More Business (1998 & 2001) and Many Clouds (2015 & 2017) have been the two dual winners.

MOST SUCCESSFUL OWNER

The most successful outright owners are John Hales (1997 One Man & 2011 Neptune Collonges) and Trevor Hemmings (2015 & 2017 Many Clouds) with two wins each. Paul Barber owned dual winner See More Business (1998 and 2011) in partnerships with John Keighley and Sir Robert Ogden respectively. The last-named also saw his colours carried to victory by Exotic Dancer (2007).

MOST SUCCESSFUL TRAINER

Paul Nicholls has recorded five victories so far, through See More Business (1998 & 2001), Taranis (2010), Neptune Collonges (2011) and Frodon (2019).

MOST SUCCESSFUL JOCKEY

Sir A P McCoy is the most successful rider with three triumphs - Cyfor Malta (1999), Exotic Dancer (2007) and Neptune Collonges (2011).

Among current jockeys, Richard Johnson is top with two victories - Behrajan (2003) and Smad Place (2016).

The only amateur rider to succeed has been Jim Wilson, who partnered Little Owl in 1981. The pair followed up in the Cheltenham Gold Cup seven weeks later.

MARES

Two mares have been successful - Lesley Ann (1982) and Dubacilla (1994).

GREYS

Four greys have won - One Man (1997), Grey Abbey (2005), Neptune Collonges (2011) and Smad Place (2016).

BETTING

The race was staged at Wincanton in 2006 after Cheltenham could not race because of frost. The Seamus Mullins-trained See You Sometime was sent off the 18/1 outsider of five - the longest-priced winner.

The shortest-priced winner was One Man, who obliged at odds of 2/5 in 1997.

However, favourites have gained success in just seven of the 37 runnings (just under 19 per cent).

The most recent market leader to prevail was the Martin Pipe-trained Cyfor Malta way back in 1999.

AGE

See More Business (2001), Grey Abbey (2005) and See You Sometime (2006) are the three oldest winners of the Cotswold Chase - all were aged 11.

At the other end of the spectrum, six-year-old Cyfor Malta was the youngest horse to score in 1999.

DID YOU KNOW?

Four Paddy Power Cotswold Chase winners have subsequently gone on to glory in the Magners Cheltenham Gold Cup.

The Peter Easterby-trained **Little Owl** won the Cotswold Chase in 1981 before taking chasing's Blue Riband in the same year.

Master Oats achieved the same feat for trainer Kim Bailey in 1995.

See More Business, successful in the 1998 Cotswold Chase and then again in 2001, captured the Cheltenham Gold Cup in 1999, while **Looks Like Trouble** achieved the double in 2000 for trainer Noel Chance.

Dawn Run, who won one of the most memorable renewals Cheltenham Gold Cup in 1986, ran in the Cotswold Chase prior to her famous victory.

Starting the 4/9 favourite, the great mare looked to be well in command when unseating her rider Tony Mullins at the 16th fence. She was remounted to finish fourth behind Misty Spirit.

She returned to Cheltenham in March to land chasing's championship event and remains the only horse to win both the Champion Hurdle and the Cheltenham Gold Cup.

Three Paddy Power Cotswold Chase winners have gone on to win the Randox Health Grand National, the most recent being the Oliver Sherwood-trained Many Clouds in 2015.

West Tip (1985) and Neptune Collonges (2011) both scored at Aintree the year after their Cheltenham triumphs.

The Giant Bolster, who retired at the age of 11 in November, 2016, had a remarkable record at Cheltenham Racecourse, both on Festival Trials Day and at The Festival.

He won three times on Festival Trials Day, taking the Timeform Novices' Handicap Chase in 2011, the G3 Paddy Power 45 Sleeps To Cheltenham Trophy Handicap Chase in 2012 and the G2 Cotswold Chase in 2014.

Trained by David Bridgwater and owned by Simon Hunt and Gary Lambton, he also ran fourth in the Cotswold Chase in both 2015 and 2016.

The Giant Bolster took part at The Festival for seven consecutive years, finishing second, third and fourth in the Magners Cheltenham Gold Cup.
