1. Parents can prepare their students that are returning to school for their new roles. Things will look different for every student role.
2. New bell schedule starts for everyone on February 16.
3. School has implemented new cleaning and disinfecting protocols for high traffic/touch areas.
4. Students will need their fully charged laptops everyday.
5. Students need their own materials. Nothing will be shared. Students can bring their own wipes for their desks if they want. (Desks will not be cleaned between every class).
6. If students have a class with a virtual teacher and monitor in classroom, they will receive a letter stating the class and situation.
7. Transportation will be contacting parents about bus schedule next week.
8. Bused students will enter through doors 1 and 2, kiss and ride through same doors as last year (5 and 13?)
9. Dismissal will be by floor and room to pace students and facilitate distancing.
10. After School help and clubs by appointment with a teacher only. No after school bus.
11. Cafeteria is single desks, with promotion of eating outside on good weather days.
12. Adults in classroom will sign in and out to record their presence in the rooms.
13. EHS has 2 Care rooms for suspected cases (symptom specific) of COVID19, these are not the Health Room. Parents will be notified to pick up student immediately.
14. If a student is exposed to COVID19 they are to stay home for 14 days (fully online school), if a student HAS COVID19: 10 days at home and a note from doctor saying ok to return to school.
