Appointment of Agent for the Sale of Chametz

If possible, all chametz -- leavened foods which are prohibited during Passover: wheat, barley, oats, spelt, and rye that has been allowed to leaven, plus rice, millet, corn, and legumes (Ashkenazi custom) or materials containing such food -- should be destroyed or given away before the holiday begins. Should this be impossible, the chametz may be stored in such a way that we are sure not to use it during the holiday and its actual ownership is transferred to a non-Jew until the holiday ends.

It is customary to make a donation for **Maot Chittim** -- literally 'wheat money' -- so that those without means will be able to prepare for the holiday. We donate these contributions to **MAZON - A Jewish Response to Hunger** (www.mazon.org).
