



## Seal Beach Center Reopening June 29<sup>th</sup>

Greetings Parents! Thank you for your patience and flexibility as we deal with California's State-Wide Stay At Home orders. As we reopen, we are making some changes to our policies and center practices to better protect our students and instructors. Please note that we will continue to offer our Mathnasium@Home platform.

### New Summer Hours of Operation\*

Monday to Thursday:	12:00 pm - 3:00 pm (Online)
	3:00 pm - 6:00 pm (Online & In-center)
Sunday:	11:00 am - 3:00 pm (Online & In-center)

\*This schedule will go into effect on Monday, June 29th

**Scheduled Sessions:** To ensure a limited number of students in-center at any hour, students must have a scheduled in-center session prior to coming into the center. Please use our [online scheduling tool](#) or email to set up your student(s)'s sessions.

**Face Coverings:** All students and employees must wear a face mask or face shield. We cannot make exceptions at this time. If your students need a face mask, please contact us.

**Waiver:** Parents or guardians must complete a liability waiver form before starting in-center sessions.

**Student Health:** If your student is feeling sick or has a runny nose, cough, fever, etc. we will reschedule your session for when they are feeling better.

### New Sign In/Out Procedures

When your student enters the center, our staff will log them in via our center tablet. We will use Non-contact Infrared Thermometers to take their temperature – temperature must be below 100.0° F. Students will be asked to use hand sanitizer, wash their hands, and sit in a designated seat assigned by the instructor/staff member (See pictures below). Instructors will log the student in and retrieve their learning binder for them. All seats are now 6 feet apart from each other. Tables will be cleaned and cleared between students.

Only students and instructors are allowed to be inside the center. After your student(s)'s session has ended, we will log them out and return their binder to the bookcase. They will wash their hands again and sit in one of the waiting area chairs for parent pickup. We will clean the waiting area chairs before the next student(s) arrive. Staff will wipe down binders and return them to the shelf. **Students do not need to use the tablets to check in/out.**



### Updated Center Layout

To accommodate social distancing guidelines, we have rearranged our center to follow the 6 feet distance rule (See pictures below). As a result, **we will implement an eight student limit each hour.** Each student station is equipped with hand sanitizer and alcohol wipes. We have installed sneeze guards at each table as a barrier between instructors and students.

All high traffic surfaces will be cleaned hourly. Students will have their own pencils, erasers, and scratch paper. We will still have all of our Mathnasium wheel and fun rewards! Instructors will be happy to retrieve rewards for student(s). If a student chooses to have a snack as their reward, we will get it for them and they will not be permitted to eat in the center. If they complete a mastery check, we will spin the wheel for them.



## Summary

In addition to these changes to our center, we promise to adhere to strict cleaning guidelines. We will continue to adopt additional safety measures as they are announced.
