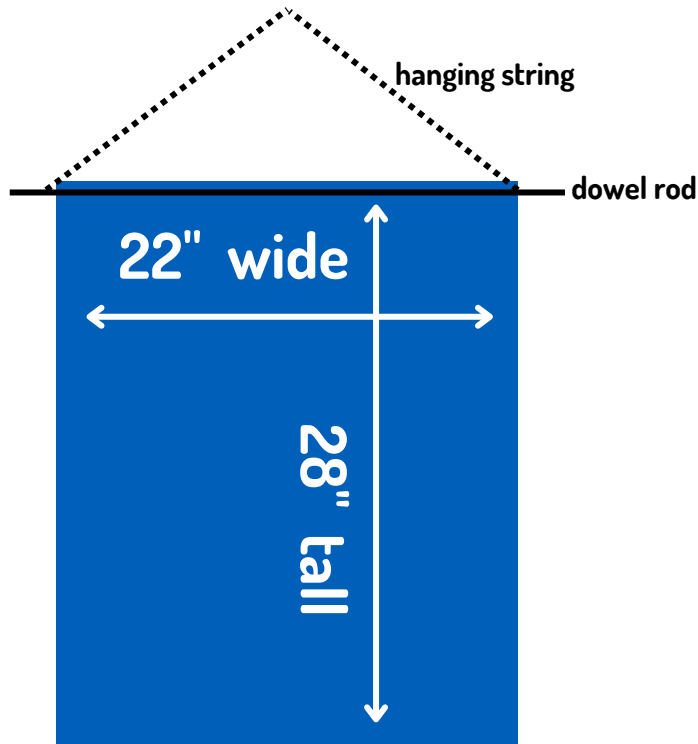


Easy Instructions to Make a 22" x 28" Conference Banner



Steps:

1. Prepare the Fabric - use any color fabric you like.

- Measure and cut the cloth to 24" wide x 31" tall to allow for hemming.
- Iron the fabric if necessary to remove wrinkles.

2. Create a Hem

- Fold 1 inch of fabric inward on each edge and secure with sewing pins.
- Sew a straight hem along all four edges with a sewing machine, or use fabric glue to secure the folds.

3. Make a Dowel Pocket

- At the top of the banner, fold down an additional 2 inches of fabric to form a pocket for the dowel rod.
- Sew or glue the folded edge, leaving the sides open for the dowel to slide through.

4. Design the Banner

- Use stencils, fabric paints, markers or a vinyl transfer to add text, logos, or designs.
Ae any color scheme you like. will do.
- Include your Conference name (bold lettering for visibility) .
- If using paint, allow the paint to dry completely before proceeding.

5. Insert the Dowel Rod

- Slide the wooden dowel rod through the pocket at the top of the banner.

6. Attach the Hanging String

- Tie one end of the string securely around each side of the dowel rod.
