In Recognition of Filipino American History Month

October 1-31, 2022

WHEREAS, 30 years ago in 1992, the Filipino American National Historical Society first introduced October as Filipino American Month; and

WHEREAS, in 2009, the U.S. Congress later recognized October as Filipino American History Month; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees recognizes that our strength as a nation and as a community comes from our diversity, and honoring individual cultures and their histories is a critical part of that; and

WHEREAS, Filipino American History Month highlights the incredible achievements and contributions of Filipino Americans and the economic, cultural, social, and patriotic contributions they make in countless ways toward the betterment of our community, schools, state, and country; and

WHEREAS, over the years, Filipino educators have relocated to the United States to help fill the shortage of teacher positions and appreciating the opportunity of experiencing and creating a life in the United States while serving students with passion and skill; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Twin Rivers Unified School District in Sacramento County, California, does hereby adopt Resolution No. 1122 to recognize Filipino American History Month and to mark the achievements and contributions of Filipino Americans in Sacramento County and throughout the United States.
