## **RESOLUTION NO. 1131**

## RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TWIN RIVERS UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS RELATED TO CEQA AND AUTHORIZING STAFF TO FILE A NOTICE OF EXEMPTION FOR THE FOOTHILL HIGH SCHOOL POOL COMPLEX REPLACEMENT PROJECT

**WHEREAS**, the Twin Rivers Unified School District ("District") owns certain real property located at 5000 McCloud Drive, Sacramento, CA 95841, know as Foothill High School ("Property");

WHEREAS, the District is seeking to improve the Property, by proceeding with the Foothill High School Pool Complex Replacement Project ("Project"), which consists of demolition of the existing pool, replacement of the pool with a new 44 meter by 25 yard pool with bathhouse and mechanical room, improved ADA paths of travel and associated ramps and parking areas, and installation of new pool lighting, shade canopy, and bleachers around the pool;

**WHEREAS**, the District has adequate funding for renovation projects from Capital Facilities Funds to proceed with the planning and implementation of the Project;

WHEREAS, the District analyzed the Project in accordance with the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") as set forth in the California Public Resources Code, section 21000 et seq., and State CEQA Guidelines and has found that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA and will therefore file a Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk;

**WHEREAS**, California Code of Regulations, Title 14, section 15302, provides a Class 2 categorical exemption for replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structures will be located on the same site as the replaced structures and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the replaced structures;

WHEREAS, the Project will consist of the replacement of the existing school pool, pool deck, pool house, and associated access ways on the site of the existing pool complex, which will be located on the same school site and have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the replaced structures, and thus, the District has determined that the Project falls within the Class 2 categorical exemption for replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities;

**WHEREAS**, the District has considered whether there are any known facts associated with the Project, including the structures and their location that, pursuant to section 15300.2 of the CEQA Guidelines, would give rise to circumstances or considerations that disallow reliance on these categorical exemptions and has determined that no such facts exist;

**WHEREAS**, the District has determined, more specifically, (i) that the on-campus location of the Project is not a "particularly sensitive environment" within the meaning of CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, subdivision (a); (ii) that the Project, combined with successive

projects of the same type in the same location, will not create a significant cumulative impact; (iii) that there are no unusual circumstances creating a reasonable possibility that the Project will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances; (iv) that the Project will not result in damages to scenic resources within a highway officially designated as a state scenic highway; (v) that the location for the Project is not a hazardous waste site included on a list compiled pursuant to Government Code section 65962.4; and (vi) that the Project will not cause any substantial adverse change in the significance of any historical resource;

WHEREAS, the District has also considered whether the Project would cause any significant effects relating to traffic, noise, air quality, or water quality and has determined that no such effects would occur; and

**WHEREAS,** upon determining that the Project is exempt from CEQA, the District is entitled to file a Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk pursuant to California Code of Regulations, Title 14, section 15062.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** the Board of Trustees of the Twin Rivers Unified School District does hereby resolve, determine, and order as follows:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby adopted as true and correct.
- The District has considered whether the Project will have a significant impact on the environment and has determined that no such impact exists based on its review and analysis.
- 3. The Project falls within the California Code of Regulations, Title 14, section 15302, Class 2 categorical exemption because the replaced structures will have substantially the sample purpose and capacity as the existing structures.
- 4. The Project location is not a "particularly sensitive environment" within the meaning of CEQA Guidelines.
- 5. The Project will not result in damage to scenic resources within an official state scenic highway pursuant to Public Resources Code, section 21084, subdivision (c).
- 6. The Project is not located on a hazardous waste and substances site pursuant to Public Resources Code, section 21084, subdivision (d).
- 7. The Project will not cause a substantial adverse change in the significance of a historical resource pursuant to Public Resources Code, section 21084, subdivision (e).
- 8. The Project will not create a significant cumulative impact, and there is no reasonable possibility that the Project will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances.
- 9. The District's Superintendent or designee thereof is directed to file the Notice of Exemption from CEQA consistent with this resolution, attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, with the County Clerk.

10. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
