



Prayers Can Work Miracles But They Can't Pay the Bills

Our annual budget is now about \$389,450 and has remained stable in recent years. About 4% of our budget is spent on discretionary items such as Outreach and Church Programs such as Youth and Sunday School education and music. Our biggest expenses are clergy salaries and benefits and general overhead to operate (insurance, utilities, etc.)

Pledging is by far our biggest source of income. Investment income and fund raisers really help, but pledging covers about 71% of our needs. It is also vital because the church can plan its spending for the year responsibly. We are not increasing the budget this year.


