Through partnerships across Greater Boston, GBJCL engages volunteer tutors in school-based, one-to-one literacy tutoring, mentoring, book drives, and advocacy efforts in under-served communities. Members of our congregation currently volunteer as reading tutors in the East Somerville Community School and the Plympton Elementary School in Waltham. Both schools are eager to have new and gently used books for their students.
