FOR BACHELOR'S DEGREE STUDENTS

Applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Declared major must be Mining Engineering or a related field.¹
- Must be classified as a sophomore, a junior, or a senior in their major.
- Must have an overall GPA of 3.4 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
- Must be an Illinois resident at the time of application or have work experience in Illinois.
- 2nd and 3rd year applicants must have completed a work program in the mining industry.¹ Qualifying programs include internships, student research, and summer jobs.

Applications² consist of the following:

- Resume (1-page maximum) showing state of residency and mining-related work experience.
- Transcript (unofficial) showing declared major and overall GPA.

FOR ASSOCIATE'S DEGREE AND CERTIFICATE PROGRAM STUDENTS

Applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Must be enrolled in an Illinois-based academic institution.
- Must have completed at least 1 semester in a mining related program.¹
- Must have an overall GPA of 3.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
- Transcript must reflect strong interest in mining or a related field.¹

*Applications*² *consist of the following:*

• Unofficial transcript showing degree/certificate program enrolled in and overall GPA.
