2021 Fall Fellowship – FAQ

I see on the flyer there is swimming, presentations, pizza and recognition, what is this all about?

The TNL lodge annually hosts an event where Order of the Arrow members can come and have fun. This year we are hosting the annual recognition event at the same time as the Fall Fellowship. So, two events in one!

We have swimming during the afternoon, where the Great Wolf Lodge water park is open for us starting at 2 pm and closes at 8 pm. During this same time, in the swimming area, there will be informational sessions where you can learn about NOAC, OA High Adventure and if you are new to OA, learn about everything OA has to offer. After swimming, the Full Package includes Pizza in the basement banquet room.

Who can attend the event?

Any OA member is welcome to attend the events. Adults and Youth! All parts of the event are open to all who register. **Pre-registration is strongly encouraged as we have limited numbers** for swimming and for seats in the banquet room. Register Early!!

Besides Registering and bringing my swimming suite, is there anything else I need to do?

YES, on the registration site are two forms which must be filled out and copies provided at registration. Your health form (parts A and B) and a copy of the Northern Star Scouting's Health screening checklist.

I am confused, there are there two different information sessions?

Yes, there are two different informational options. First, we have reserved a room, inside the water park area, where the Scouters who are swimming can go, ask questions, and learn about NOAC (the 2022 National OA event in Knoxville Tennessee), OA High Adventure options (Philmont, Sea Base, Northern Tier, Summit Bechtel Reserve). In this same room there will be a short presentation for all new OA members to learn about the Order of the Arrow. The time for this presentation will be posted. Everyone coming to the room to learn can enter in a prize drawing! So, if you are swimming, take a short break and stop in and learn more about OA.

Concurrent with the water park session, we wanted to have something for the Adults and Youth who did not want to swim. So, from 4-6 PM we will have an update on the National Boy Scouts of America, and the Order of the Arrow. This will be held in the Ballroom. Topics will include the status of both national organizations, as well as an interactive opportunity to help improve the future of our lodge. Registration is required (Partial C option - including the meal and recognition event).

Once I get there where will the Registration table be?

The registration table will be near the hotel registration desk. The door is located on the south side of the building, if you come in on the water park entrance (East side of the building), just keep walking to the hotel lobby.

Can I just attend the Recognition Event at 7:30 pm?

Yes, and registration is free, but you **must register as space is limited**. The check-in table will be in the hotel lobby. We also plan on providing the option to watch the recognition event from your home as we will be broadcasting the recognition event.

Will there be something to eat?

Yes, if you sign up for the Full or Partial C options, pizza is included. If you sign up for the water park only option B, there are food options available for purchase from the hotel. See their web site for more information about Buckets located inside the water park area:
