

Thank you for taking part in the Bellevue Christian summer reading program. We hope you enjoy discovering new books through this fun reading challenge based on the popular Bingo game.

Choose the square you want to do. Then, read the book or do the activity. When you are done, write the title of the book in the square or describe what you did if you did an activity. Last, color in the square so can see your progress!

Your first goal is to complete a *row*—a bingo. A “bingo” represents a completed line across or down or even diagonally across. For added challenge, you can go for multiple bingos, or cover the whole board, which is called a “*blackout*.”


