Clerk's Report (Membership):

Membership year-to-date is 790 compared to 781 in 2020. Attendance in September was 1456 in person and 304 online for an average of 440 including both services. In 2020, there were 298 in building and 48 online in two services. Year-to-date there have been 13 baptisms compared to 10 in 2020. Finance Committee Report:

In September the church budget collections were \$24,244.03 on a budget of \$24,805 for a shortage of \$560.97. Tithe collections were \$89,186.74 for September. In comparison, year-to-date tithe collections are \$967,679.72 compared to \$1,040,138.22 in 2020 and \$777,055.23 in 2019. The Building Fund balance is \$184,263.54. Plans are to spend up to \$150,000 for the kitchen and any extra will be put towards media ministry. Donations can be made to the Building Fund.

 - Series: Archeology may be held in the Fellowship Hall. Dr. Scott Baker will do this presentation on October 25 and 26. Other series are Come Alive in Prayer and Creation and Serpentine with the VOP.
 - Compassion – Starting November 6, plans are to have a meal together and invite people to work in their community. There are 30 ministries at Campion that members can participate in. It would be wonderful if Campion could be the heart of the community by finding ways for non-members to participate in ministries.
- Discipleship: How does discipleship work in our church. What are the steps and processes that we need to go through? Pastor Taylor talked about how to build a team around them. What does growth look like?
