2. Water filters for RO system: \$750
3. 10 zone irrigation system: \$1500, help planning this would also be welcome.
4. 4 Damm "400 Aluminum Water Breaker Nozzle" watering wands with 24" handles and "Touch N' Flow Pro" trigger valves to replace sun rotted or broken water nozzles.
5. Fix, replace, and update hand tool inventory: \$700
6. Replacement handles for shovels, garden rakes, rakes, picks and mattocks.
7. A couple of broad forks
8. Wolf Garten stirrup hoe with adjustable handle and other attachments.
9. Fix broken tillers and chipper shredder, equipment maintenance: \$1500
10. Fix or replace swamp coolers: \$700
