Clerk's Report (Membership):

Finance Committee Report:

Church budget collections were \$29,861.87 on a budget of \$24,805 for an overage of \$5,056.87. Tithe collections were \$152,888.14 compared to \$285,469.01 in 2020 and \$256,955.52 on 2019. The building loan outstanding balance is \$47,406.60. Donations to the building fund averages about \$7,000 per month. The amount the conference will pay is about \$40,000 but will not come for possibly another two year.

Watchloveandwar.com is an online digital series for our community.

The No More Fear Series will start April 28. Plans are to send an invitation to names that are on our records and church members as well as use social media. Andrews Study Bibles will be given to guests and any member that brings a guest. Plans are to set up Bible studies with about 30 persons and once the Bible studies are done, the guest gets to keep the Bible. A motion was made that we accept this report:

2021 Church Budget Revision

Below are the changes to the church budget which will be brought to the business meeting for approval in May. The Finance Committee felt that we should use this money on ministries that are active. This is just for this year. The Finance Committee recommends a revision to our church budget based on an updated and much lower budget [-\$13,341.86] for our building insurance. Finance Committee recommends we continue with our sum-total budget but replace the above amount with the following:

- HMS - \$1000 – a one time
- Special Sabbaths(new) – \$1,541.86
- Discipleship(#1735) - \$1,000
- Youth/Young Adult(#1700) & (#1735) - \$1,000
- Reserve(#1900) – \$5,000
- Prayer Ministry(#1882) - \$300
- Media(#1371) - \$3,000
- Organ maintenance (add back) – \$500
- Children's Sabbath School classes(add to #1340) - \$1,000 divided

\$13,341.86 - Total

A motion was made that we send this to a business meeting.
