Spectators and Visitors update of the Return to Play Policies:

On September 2, 2020 the PA Department of Health updated the Guidance for All Sports to include spectators at sporting events, but the spectators will count towards the statewide large gathering limitations in the Green Phase (25 or fewer people indoors, 250 or fewer outdoors), and they must follow the Universal Face Covering Order and social distancing guidance when arriving, attending, and departing the event.

At Harrisburg Academy Upper Field and John Crain Kunkel Complex (JCK Complex):

1. Spectator areas, including bleachers, must adhere to social distancing requirements of at least 6 feet of spacing for anyone not in the same household. To assist with proper social distancing, seating areas will be clearly marked. Spectators should sit on the marked spots on the bleachers. We encourage spectators to bring their own chair to the games.
2. Spectators must wear face coverings and/or face shields with mask at all times while being six feet apart.
3. Spectators should not enter the field of play or bench areas.
4. Visitors, spectators, and volunteers will be limited when possible, including activities with external groups or organizations.
